

ENROLLMENT BY GENDER










TOTAL COHORT RESULTS IN SECONDARY-LEVEL MATHEMATICS AFTER FOUR YEARS OF INSTRUCTION






SECONDARY-LEVEL ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS RESULTS FOR ACCOUNTABILITY







SECONDARY-LEVEL MATHEMATICS RESULTS FOR ACCOUNTABILITY






UNWEIGHTED COMBINED ELA AND MATH PIS






OVERALL GRADUATION RATE FOR ACCOUNTABILITY



FOUR-YEAR GRADUATION-RATE TOTAL COHORT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY






